**NEW YORK PROCESS SERVERS GRANTED  
PARTIAL RESTRAINING ORDER ON NEW LAW**

*Groups continue to work toward agreement*

(New York City, N.Y.) – The New York State Professional Process Servers Association (NYSPPSA) was granted a partial restraining order on March 21 to allow the Association and the City of New York to continue negotiations over new regulations for professional process servers within the city limits.

The association and its members remain hopeful that differences can be resolved amicably and to the satisfaction of all parties.

Prior to the court filing, NYSPPSA and the City of New York had been negotiating in good faith and were making progress ahead of a March 21 deadline. NYSPPSA chose court action only after a request to extend that deadline was denied. In the event the matter cannot be resolved satisfactorily, further court proceedings are set for April 27.

NYSPPSA is a chartered state association of the National Association of Professional Process Servers (NAPPS).
